RE: SY2020-21 MEAL PRICE INCREASE

According to the Paid Lunch Equity Tool for SY2020-21 an increase in student meal prices is necessary in order to meet the federal price increase requirements for the National School Lunch Program. (We've been fortunate that we haven't been required to increase prices since SY2017-18). The proposed increases are as follows:

Reduced remains .40

Full Price lunch at Central and Kershaw from \$2.45 to \$2.55 (an increase of \$16.90 per student per year)

Full Price lunch at SSJH, SSHS and Valley View Alternative from \$2.70 to \$2.80 (an increase of \$16.90 per student per year)

Our district no longer qualifies for Provision 2 (free) Breakfast. The proposed prices for breakfast are as follows:

Reduced .30

Central and Kershaw \$1.50

SSJH, SSHS and Valley View Alternative \$1.70
