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Professional Development Course 2023-24 *Dyslexia For Idaho Certificated Staff*

Course Title(s):

- *Dyslexia for Idaho Certificated Staff*

Overview:

This course is designed for Sugar-Salem Joint School District #322 educational community members to receive recertification credit for professional development activities that meet the requirements as outlined by ISDE. A total of 15 training hours need to be documented by the course facilitator and provide the district staff member a certificate of completion that will need to be submitted as part of the required assignment for this course.

Training requirements for recertification have to be completed through an approved/vetted vendor by the ISDE.

Who does this requirement apply to?

- All Idaho instructional staff, administrators, or pupil personnel staff with the following endorsements:
- all subjects (K-8)
- exceptional child generalist
- blended early childhood/early childhood special education
- administrator serving students from kindergarten through grade 5 at the time of renewal
- school counselor serving students from kindergarten through grade 5 at the time of renewal **{District recommendation is for all K-12 counselors and admin complete this requirement}**

Registration:

- Participants can register between August 1, 2023 and May 1, 2024.
- Extensions to this timeline will not be granted.

Course Work:

- Course work needs to be completed between August 1, 2023 and June 15, 2024.

Grading:

Upon completion of the course, grading will be based on a pass/fail system given specific assignments completed and turned into instructor.

- 1 credit

Q/A:

Can a staff member receive their 15 hours of PD training from an alternative method?

Yes, however, it will be up to that staff member to research out and determine if the method they choose is an approved provider as authorized by the ISDE for recertification.

Do you need a transcribed course to meet the ISDE recertification requirement?

No, you just need the documentation from the vendor, (i.e. certificate) that you have completed their dyslexia course and that it is at least 15 hours or more of training.

Why get this credit?

By completing the dyslexia training and completing this course as outlined in the course outline, you will have complete potentially two parts of your next recertification, 1 transcript credit and the dyslexia requirement.
