*Please note, we only accept children between the ages of 18 months and 36 months. Once they turn 3 years old, they are ineligible to attend our program. If your child turns 3 during our program, we will most likely not accept them into our program.

The ECSE 350 L course is taken by ECSE majors as part of a required experience for their major. The students will come to your home and complete a developmental assessment with you and your child. They will write lesson plans for play based activities to do in class based on the assessment data. They will then spend time with you while your child plays in class, coaching you on strategies to help your child on their goals and developmental needs.
